2 Hang the free-falling part next to the box and pipe rail trolley. Hang the hooks on the crop wire one by one. The J.S. system eliminates the need to unwind the hooks, which results in fast, efficient work and less labour.

During cultivation, the plant grows and the hook is unwound further and furthe The hook moves further and further along on the crop wire. The total length of the fully grown plant determines the total length of the twine on the high wire
hook. The length of the fully grown plant (B) and the length of the free-falling part (A) determine the length of the twine on the wrapped hook (C).
