Biophos™ is a powder formulation of bio-activated Phosphorus for incorporation in composts, potting media and soils.

Key benefits

- 11% Organic bio-active form of Phosphorus.
- 36% Calcium.
- Contains naturally occurring trace elements.
- Promotes early root development in plants including seedlings, bedding, potted colour, perennials, trees and shrubs.
- Can also be used in potting media, under cover production and broadacre crops.



Application rates

Media	Rate
Compost	1 - 2 kg / m ³
Potting media	0.5 - 1.0 kg / m ³
Soil grown crops (broadcast and incorporate)	250 - 500 kg / ha or 2.5 - 5 kg / 100 m ² or 25 - 50 g / m ²

Note: Do not use for NZ natives, palms and other phosphate-sensitive plants such as many Australian & South African natives e.g.: Protea, Leucodendrons, Grevillea and Boronia.

Additional benefits for broadacre crops

- Increases biomass in the soil, thus contributing to soil fertility.
- "Sweetens" soils: does not increase soil acidity.
- Improves soil structure.
- Long term benefits.
