Product Description:

CARNAUBA CITRUS is a carnauba wax designed to function as a post harvest coating for citrus. Is also classified as an organic coating. Castle Chemicals are Australia's No.1 manufacturer of citrus and apple waxes and competes against all imported wax, on technical, service and performance.

CARNUABA CITRUS is Australia's only citrus carnauba coating which complies with *FSANZ codes. (*Food Standard Australia New Zealand).

CARNAUBA CITRUS is proven as a market performer in all export and domestic markets. Used by leading packers overseas. CARNUABA CITRUS provides high gloss (over prolonged storage), which is suitable for both export and domestic shipments. The shine level of CARNAUBA CITRUS is very good compared to other carnauba based waxes.

CARNAUBA CITRUS is used to:

Reduce Pitting: Stimulated by low levels of oxygen. Reduce Off-Flavours: During anaerobic respiration.

Minimise Whitening: Less chance of whitening compared to shellac waxes.

Application:

CARNAUBA CITRUS is best applied through the Micron 2000. It is important to have the citrus dry before waxing. Preparation is the most important aspect before waxing. This allows lasting shine. CARNAUBA CITRUS can be applied at a reduce rate compared to other types of citrus coatings.

Talk with Castle Chemicals experienced Technical staff about getting the best out of CARNAUBA CITRUS. Each packing line is different. There are at least 8 areas on the packing line that influence your result.
