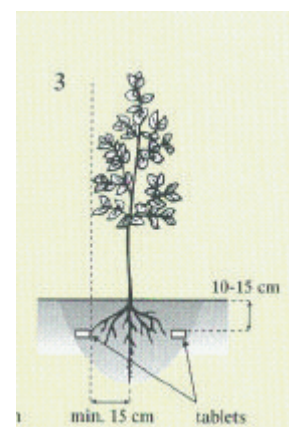


Application

Use one tablet for each 1 litre bag / pot size, or for each litre of soil in the planting hole.

| Litres of soil | Plant height | Number of tablets |
|----------------|---------------|-------------------|
| 1 | up to 300 mm | 1 |
| 2 | up to 600 mm | 2 |
| 3 | 600 mm to 1 m | 3 |
| 4 to 6 | 1 to 2 m | 4 |
| 6 to 10 | 2 to 3 m | 5 |
| 10 to 20 | 3 to 4 m | 6 |

- Place tablets 10 to 15 cm under the soil surface.
- Tablets should be placed at least 15 cm from plant stems, and no more than 10 cm out from the plants drip line. Or place tablets under the root bundle and not in direct contact with roots.
- Place multiple tablets evenly around the plant or plant's root ball.
